For this reason, communists are obliged to collectively elaborate common and possible united actions to move a step forward to confront and check the advance of imperialist plans. This includes the need to further develop and strengthen the organization of the masses, provide the needed leadership to defeat and the forces of imperialism and local reaction What is at stake at present, especially under the spread of Covid-19, is the peoples living standard, especially the working class the peasantry. It the prime task of the communists is to strife towards the unity of the working class as the main stay for the coordination of the struggle of the broader masses and the establishment of the national democratic front to complete successfully the tasks of this revolutionary stage and build the basis for socialist transformation.

Comrades, Following the high political mass struggle in Sudan and the success of the December Uprising in shaking the foundation of the dictatorial regime and removing Albashir, International, regional and internal reactionary forces in collusion with right wing elements within the opposition conspired against the radical changes demanded by the masses. They staged a palace coup, installed a military council, and with the help of regional reactionary forces established a partnership between the generals and certain civilian forces.

On the other hand stand the forces for radical change demanding the dismantling and liquidation of the regime, and the establishment of a complete civil power and government.
